







GSA LIBERATION DAY PICNIC BARBECUE CONTEST

Rules and Procedures:

BARBECUE ENTRIES MUST BE TURNED-IN BY NOON

- 1. Barbeque entry is for Chicken Only Any Part of the Chicken
- 2. Barbeque entries may be brought from home or prepared on site and placed in an aluminum container provided by the BBQ Committee, which consist of 3 volunteers and a GSA Officer
- 3. All entries will be assigned a letter when turned in with the same letter given to the participant in a sealed envelope that cannot be opened until the end of contest
- 4. People's Choice All entries will be 'Judged' by picnic attendees. Each 'Judge' will pay \$3.00 to participate in sampling the entries. The BBQ Committee will provide sampling materials; plates, forks, napkins, etc.
- 6. Each 'Judge' will be given a ballot and will pick 1^{st} , 2^{nd} & 3^{rd} from the entries after sampling them. A ballot box will be provided and all ballots will be counted by the BBQ Committee
- 7. BBQ Committee members cannot participate in the contest; however, their family members can.
- 8. Results will be based on the highest votes for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} & 3^{rd} . Example; the highest votes for 1^{st} will get First Place but the second highest votes in the first place ballots will not get 2^{nd} place. The highest votes for 2^{nd} place will win Second Place and the highest votes for 3^{rd} place will win Third Place
- 9. 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} place winners will receive cash prizes generated from the judge's fee; 1^{st} 45%, 2^{nd} 30% & 3^{rd} 20% and only the 1^{st} place winner's name will be placed on the GSA Winners plaque
- 10. The 5% from the judge's fee will be used to offset the cost of the containers, plates, forks, napkins, etc.
- 11. The BBQ Committee GSA Officer will verify the results and all results are final
